

## **BEHAVIOUR IN EXAMINATIONS.**

- You should wait quietly outside the examination room.
- When the invigilator tells you, you should enter the room in silence and sit where the invigilator tells you.
- In the examination room you should be silent.
- If there is revision time – revise quietly. Once any student has started an examination, all students must be completely silent.
- There should be silence during the whole of the examination, until you leave the examination room.
- You must not attempt to communicate with any other student. This will be viewed as cheating.
- If you break these rules, your paper will be taken from you and you will be removed from the examination room by a senior member of staff.
- Your parents will be informed.
- You will be required to take the paper again after school.
