- prepositions (dative and accusative)
- asking and giving personal details
- weather and seasons
- activities (what you did yesterday and in the holidays)
- telling the time + activities
- holidays
- travel and transport
- accommodation
- buying train tickets
- lost property
- parts of the body
- illness
- at the doctors (giving and receiving advice)
- daily routine
- food and drink
- shopping
- pocket money
- in town (buildings and where they are/directions)
- **plus last years' work!!!**

*Your speaking and writing tests will follow the GCSE format, ie you will be given a “task” and time to prepare it (either for homework or in a lesson), then for the speaking exam you will have 6 minutes in which to complete that task. In the writing exam you will have 1 hour in which to write c. 300 words. The task will relate to one of the topics studied this year, e.g. Holidays, daily routine, accidents and illness, pocket money .....*
